Up until 1850, when Muzaffargarh was created as a district and Khangarh Tehsil was annexed to it, it remained the district's administrative center.

The Honorary Court was founded in 1893 and was presided over by Nawabzada Saifullah Khan, the late statesman Nawabzada Nasrullah Khan's father. Khangarh police station was founded in 1849. It serves as a significant commercial hub for the region. Shrines for Pir Mehdi Shah and Pir Talib shah are its famous places.

  - ii. A student may be placed on probation for a fixed period.  
If during the period of probation she fails to improve her conduct, she may be rusticated or expelled.
9. College will, however, depend upon the time of the year when the penalty is imposed. The student under rustication may at the discretion of the Principal of the College be permitted to rejoin the class in the same College in the beginning of the next academic year.
10. A rusticated student once re-admitted and again found creating disturbance/ indiscipline, etc. will be expelled from the college.

## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING THE APPLICATION FORM**

1. Don't leave any column blank, If NOT APPLICABLE write N/A
2. If Student Name is different on Matric Degree and B-Form/CNIC then student name should be written as given on Matric Degree. Even spellings of Student Name should be same.
3. If Father/Guardian Name is different on Matric Degree and B-Form/CNIC then father/guardian name should be written as given on Matric Degree. Even spellings of Name should be same.
4. Date of Birth should be written according to Matric Degree (Not as on B-Form or CNIC)
  - a. (Important Note: If spellings of Name, Father Name, Date of Birth are wrong on Matric Degree, or these informations are different from B-Form/CNIC then Contact NADRA or BISE for name/date correction as early as possible).
5. Students without B-Form or CNIC No. cannot take admission.
6. For Admission in Inter, Matric should be passed in year 2023
  - a. Similarly, for admission in BS, Inter should be passed in year 2023.
  - b. Otherwise attach a stamp paper of Rs. 100 comprising on statement that your have never taken admission anywhere before submitting admission form in GGCW Muzaffargarh.  
(Sample of stamp paper is on next page)
7. Select Subjects **“Carefully”** and according to merit or eligibility criteria.
8. Select Subject carefully and according to your choice and capacity. Pre-First Year Classes can be attended in our college for all subjects offered by the college. It will help students to know about subjects and topics..
9. Change of Single Subject Fee is Rupees 1500.
10. Change of 3 Subjects Fee is  $1500 \times 3 = 4500$ .

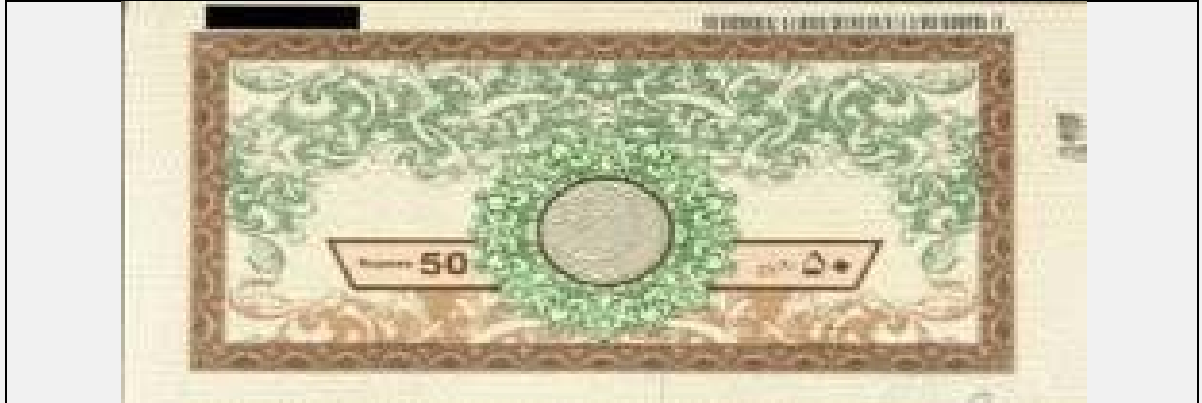
